Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions.

Where a programme includes a film in the 12A, 15 or 18 category of the British Board of Film Classification, no person appearing to be under the age of 12 (and unaccompanied in that case), 15 or 18 as appropriate shall be admitted to any part of the programme; and the licence holder shall display in a conspicuous position a notice in the following terms: -

Persons under the age of (insert appropriate age) cannot be admitted to any part of the programme. Where films of different categories form part of the same programme, the notice shall refer to the oldest age restriction. This condition does not apply to members of staff under the relevant age while on duty provided that the prior written consent of the person's parents or legal guardian has first been obtained.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

- 1. Proposed events shall be approved by the Safety Advisory Group of Hertsmere Borough Council ("the Council").
- 2. Notices of intended events shall be displayed at the entrances to the park prior to the event providing the address and telephone number of the organiser.
- 3. At all events stewards shall be employed to discourage crime and disorder and promote public safety. Hertfordshire Constabulary shall be provided with notice of intended events. Police Community Support Officers shall be invited to attend.
- (a) In relation to public safety a full risk assessment shall be undertaken prior to each event. At least 1 officer of Hertsmere Borough Council shall be present during the entire event.
- (b) At least one such officer shall have received training in administering First Aid.
- (c) A first aid kit shall be kept and maintained in the potting shed.
- 4. Only persons whose backgrounds have been approved by the Council shall be permitted to work in close proximity with or supervise children.
- 5. Noise arising from the playing of live or recorded music must not exceed an average noise level of 65 dB(A) over a 15-minute period, measured at one metre from the façade of any noise sensitive premises. Noise sensitive premises are domestic dwellings, educational establishments, hospitals and similar institutions, places of worship, and any premises used for any other purposes likely to be affected by noise.
- 6. Noise arising from the playing of live or recorded music must not exceed the background noise level by more than 15 dB(A) over a 15-minute period, measured at one metre from the façade of any noise sensitive premises.
- 7. Loudspeakers are to be aligned and orientated to minimise noise disturbance, and must be situated so that they do not point directly towards noise-sensitive premises.
- 8. A regular bulletin of forthcoming events that includes live or recorded music must be made available to all properties in the immediate vicinity of the venue.
