Covid-19: funeral guidance



Current government guidelines restrict gatherings and whilst we understand that it is a hugely difficult time to mourn a loved one, we must continue to follow these social distancing rules for public safety and to stop the spread of infection.

Only the following are allowed to attend a funeral to a maximum number of 10:

- Members of the deceaseds household (self-isolation must have been completed if the deceased had Covid-19 or showed symptoms)
- Close family members
- A small number of friends may attend but <u>only</u> in the absence of any household/family members

Those attending should action the following:

- Different households should travel to and from the venue separately
- Avoid direct physical contact e.g. hugging unless part of the same household and stand at least 2 metres apart
- Follow advice on handwashing, sneezing and coughing to reduce the spread of germs. Use of a hand sanitiser is recommended.
