In order to formalise existing parking arrangements in Manor Way Service Road, Borehamwood, Hertsmere Borough Council proposes to make new Orders. The proposals are considered necessary to retain the parking opportunity, prevent obstructive parking, help with the free flow of traffic and improve road safety within the vicinity.

Therefore, it appears to the Hertsmere Borough Council that it is necessary and expedient to make the Order in the interests of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), for preventing obstructive parking and for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

Consultation has been carried out with local and County Councillors representing the area, the Highway Authority, the local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, FTA, RHA, other local organisations and local residents.
