Statement Of Reasons for Making

THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (HEATHFIELD CLOSE and HERMITAGE COURT, POTTERS BAR) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016

Hertsmere Borough Council has made an Order to improve amenity and prevent congestion by introducing new waiting restrictions in parts of Heathfield Close and Hermitage Court, Potters Bar, as specified in the Schedule to the above mentioned Order.

The Order comprises 'no waiting at any time' restrictions to be installed at junctions to prevent inappropriate obstructive parking at corners creating restricted visibility, manoeuvrability and access problems.

This Order is necessary to improve manoeuvrability and access and to improve the amenity for residents, Hertsmere Borough Council considers that the measures are necessary and expedient in the interests of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

The measures contained in the Order have been subject to consultation with local and County Councillors representing the area, Hertfordshire County Council, the local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, other local organisations and groups and local residents.
