**Proposed amendment of Yellow Lines across driveways in The Crosspath, Radlett.**

The council has received complaints from residents regarding the difficulty of reduced visibility levels when accessing or existing driveways in some section of The Crosspath when vehicles are parked overhanging the marked parking bays.

Highway officers have observed the parking at the location which raises a safety issue for other motorists as sight lines are obscured.

It is therefore proposed, in the interest of road safety, to extend the yellow lines outside properties numbers 50 and 56. Extending the yellow lines at these locations will help improve visibility, create passing point to help reduce congestion in the road and to improve general road safety.

A plan is attached overleaf showing the proposal for your review.

Please do note that the proposed amendment will not reduce the availability of the existing kerb space parking for residents.
