

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary election For the Hertsmere constituency

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve Hertsmere.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the offices of the (Acting) Returning Officer, Hertsmere Borough Council, Elstree Way, Borehamwood, WD6 1WA, or by emailing elections@hertsmere.gov.uk
3. Nomination papers must be delivered in person to the (Acting) Returning Officer at Election Services, Hertsmere Borough Council, Elstree Way, Borehamwood, WD6 1WA on any weekday after the date of this notice between 10am to 4pm, but no later than 4pm on Friday 7 June.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as banker in the United Kingdom. Payment can also be made by electronic transfer into the Hertsmere Borough Council Account (Barclays Bank; sort code 20-74-38; account number 23930319). Please use your surname and GEN24 as reference.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 4 July.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 18 June. Applications can be made online at: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
7. New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 19 June. Postal vote applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>
9. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer in the local authority area where the elector is registered by 5pm on Thursday 2 May 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024.
