Intoxicating liquor shall not be sold or supplied on the premises otherwise than to a person taking table meals there and for consumption by such a person as ancillary to his meal.

Suitable beverages other than Intoxicating liquor-including drinking water-shall be equally available for consumption with or otherwise as an ancillary to meals in the licensed premises.
