### Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions.

No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence

- 1. At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of it or,
- 2. At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Where a programme includes a film in the 12A, 15 or 18 category of the British Board of Film Classification, no person appearing to be under the age of 12 (and unaccompanied in that case), 15 or 18 as appropriate shall be admitted to any part of the programme; and the licence holder shall display in a conspicuous position a notice in the following terms: -

Persons under the age of (insert appropriate age) cannot be admitted to any part of the programme.

Where films of different categories form part of the same programme, the notice shall refer to the oldest age restriction. This condition does not apply to members of staff under the relevant age while on duty provided that the prior written consent of the person's parents or legal guardian has first been obtained.

### Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

- 1. The premises licence holder shall provide the police with notice of all licensed events.
- 2. Ingress and egress not withstanding, all external doors and windows to the premises are to be kept closed during any musical or loud entertainment.
- 3. The fire alarm system and fire extinguishers shall be maintained in full working order. Escape routes and final exit doors should remain free from obstruction at all times.

- 4. Prominent, clear and legible notices are to be displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 5. The premises shall not be hired to persons who are under or appear to be under the age of 21 years. Adult supervision shall be provided at events attended by children.
