Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions.

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence
 - (a) At a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of it or,
- (b) At a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

2. Where a programme includes a film in the 12A, 15 or 18 category of the British Board of Film Classification, no person appearing to be under the age of 12 (and unaccompanied in that case), 15 or 18 as appropriate shall be admitted to any part of the programme; and the licence holder shall display in a conspicuous position a notice in the following terms: -

Persons under the age of (insert appropriate age) cannot be admitted to any part of the programme.

Where films of different categories form part of the same programme, the notice shall refer to the oldest age restriction. This condition does not apply to members of staff under the relevant age while on duty provided that the prior written consent of the person's parents or legal guardian has first been obtained.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

Public Safety

- 1. Break bar and crash bar final fire exits must be maintained and unobstructed.
- 2. The emergency lighting of fire exits must be of the fully maintained type.
- 3. The electrical installation shall be inspected at least once a year by a competent electrical engineer appointed by or on behalf of the premises licence holder, and a certificate stating the condition of the installation shall after each inspection be forwarded to the licensing authority by or on behalf of the premises licence holder.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

- 4. Ingress and egress not withstanding, all external doors and windows to the premises are to be kept closed during any regulated entertainment.
- 5. All external doors are to be fitted with automatic door closers. Where an external door is served by a lobby, the door closer may be fitted to the internal lobby door.
- 6. Amplified music and/or speech external to the premises is not permitted.
- 7. Prominent, clear and legible notices are to be displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 8. The tipping of bottles into receptacles external to the premises must not take place between 19:00 hours and 09:00 hours.
- 9. The use of areas external to the premises for the consumption of alcohol, other refreshment or food, is prohibited.

- 10. Ventilation ducts through external walls facing noise-sensitive premises within 100 metres must be acoustically treated.
- 11. All external doors are to be fitted with acoustic seals and threshold strips.
- 12. Loudspeakers used for regulated entertainment (other than background music) that are mounted on walls or ceilings must be acoustically isolated from the building structure.
- 13. Secondary or double-glazing is required for single glazed windows facing noise-sensitive premises within 100 metres.
- 14. Children shall be under the supervision of a responsbile adult.

The Protection of Children from harm

15. Children shall only be permitted on the premises whilst under the supervision of a responsbile adult.
