Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions.

Where a programme includes a film in the 12A, 15 or 18 category of the British Board of Film Classification, no person appearing to be under the age of 12 (and unaccompanied in that case), 15 or 18 as appropriate shall be admitted to any part of the programme; and the licence holder shall display in a conspicuous position a notice in the following terms: -

Persons under the age of (insert appropriate age) cannot be admitted to any part of the programme.

Where films of different categories form part of the same programme, the notice shall refer to the oldest age restriction. This condition does not apply to members of staff under the relevant age while on duty provided that the prior written consent of the person's parents or legal guardian has first been obtained.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

1. All events at the premises shall be supervised by responsible adults.
2. The premises licence holder shall subscribe to and follow the diocesan child protection policies.
3. The premises licence holder shall ensure that all contractors providing entertainment specifically for children hold a Criminal Records Bureau disclosure certificate.
4. The conditions of hire for the hall shall contain a clause stating that environmental health requirements must be met by ensuring that excessive noise shall not be generated by musical entertainment and further that emergency exits shall not be used for normal access to and egress from the hall.
5. Security tags shall be affixed to each emergency exit door leading out of the hall into open external areas, which shall visibly indicate that they are not to be used except for their purpose in an emergency.
