Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions.

All embedded restrictions and conditions inherent in the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 and Theatre Act 1968.

- The electrical installation shall be inspected at least once in every five years, or such lesser period as is considered appropriate to the individual case, by a competent electrical engineer appointed by or on behalf of the licensee of the premises and a certificate stating the condition of the installation shall after each inspection, be forward to the Council by or on behalf of the licensee of the premises.
- 2. The number of persons (excluding staff and attendants) to be allowed at any one time in the licensed area specified:

WALLED GARDEN shall not exceed: 750 PERSONS

- 3. The entrance/exit gates to be securely fixed open before and whilst the public are on the premises.
- 4. The length of roadway to the emergency vehicle access gate to be kept clear during performances.
- 5. Any temporary electrical installation shall comply with the Institute of Electrical Engineers Wiring Regulations. All wiring must be carried out using heavy-duty cables and to be of sufficient size to carry expected load. Any joints to be made using mechanical connectors, twisted and taped joints will not be allowed. All cable runs to be secured wherever possible at high level, if run at ground level the cables must be protected from damage.
- 6. Socket outlets for use with temporary or portable electrical equipment in area used by a band or disc jockey shall be of a type protected by a residual circuit breaker having a 30mA tripping current.
- 7. All curtains scenery and other materials used shall be either non-combustible or be treated to render it flame resistance.

FILMS

Where a programme includes a film in the 12A, 15 or 18 category of the British Board of Film Classification, no person appearing to be under the age of 12 (and unaccompanied in that case), 15 or 18 as appropriate shall be admitted to any part of the programme; and the licence holder shall display in a conspicuous position a notice in the following terms: -

Persons under the age of (insert appropriate age) cannot be admitted to any part of the programme.

Where films of different categories form part of the same programme, the notice shall refer to the oldest age restriction. This condition does not apply to members of staff under the relevant age while on duty provided that the prior written consent of the person's parents or legal guardian has first been obtained.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule.

- 1. The hire of the premises shall only take place upon the hirer agreeing in writing to the "Walled Garden Conditions of Hire" as amended from time to time. Shenley Park staff shall be on duty throughout the duration of events.
- 2. Admission to events to which the general public are invited shall be organised by and at the discretion of Shenley Park Trust.
- 3. Staff shall ensure that all events terminate and that the premises are vacated at the times prescribed in this licence. Noise or vibration shall not emanate from premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties.
- 4. Save for hire of the premises, persons who are or appear to be under the age of 18 shall not be admitted to the premises unless they are accompanied by a responsible adult.
