

Application for a Dry Cleaning Permit

Pollution Prevention and Control Act, 1999 Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010

Introduction

When to use this form

This environmental permitting regime is known as and referred to as Local Authority Pollution Prevention and Control ('LAPPC'). Installations permitted under this regime are known as Part 'B' installations. Use this form if you are sending an application for a 'Part B' permit to a Local Authority under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010 ("the EPR") to operate a dry cleaning activity.

Before you start to fill in this form

You are strongly advised to read relevant parts of the Defra general guidance manual issued for LA-IPPC and LAPPC, republished in 2010 and available at:
