

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995**

**DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4(1) TO WHICH ARTICLE 5(4) APPLIES**

**WHEREAS** THE Council of the **Borough of Hertsmere** being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4(6) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out on land shown **hatched** on the attached plan, unless permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, and

**WHEREAS** the Council consider that development of the said description is prejudicial to proper planning and would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 4 of article 5 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 apply,

**NOW THEREFORE** the said Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 **hereby direct** that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule below.

**THIS DIRECTION** is made under article 4(1) of the said Order and, in accordance with article 5(4), shall remain in force until 20<sup>th</sup> March 2001 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and shall then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions.

**SCHEDULE**

Development falling within Class A of Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 consisting of the insertion of any window or other opening in any part of the east-facing side wall of the property standing within the land shown **hatched** on the attached plan.

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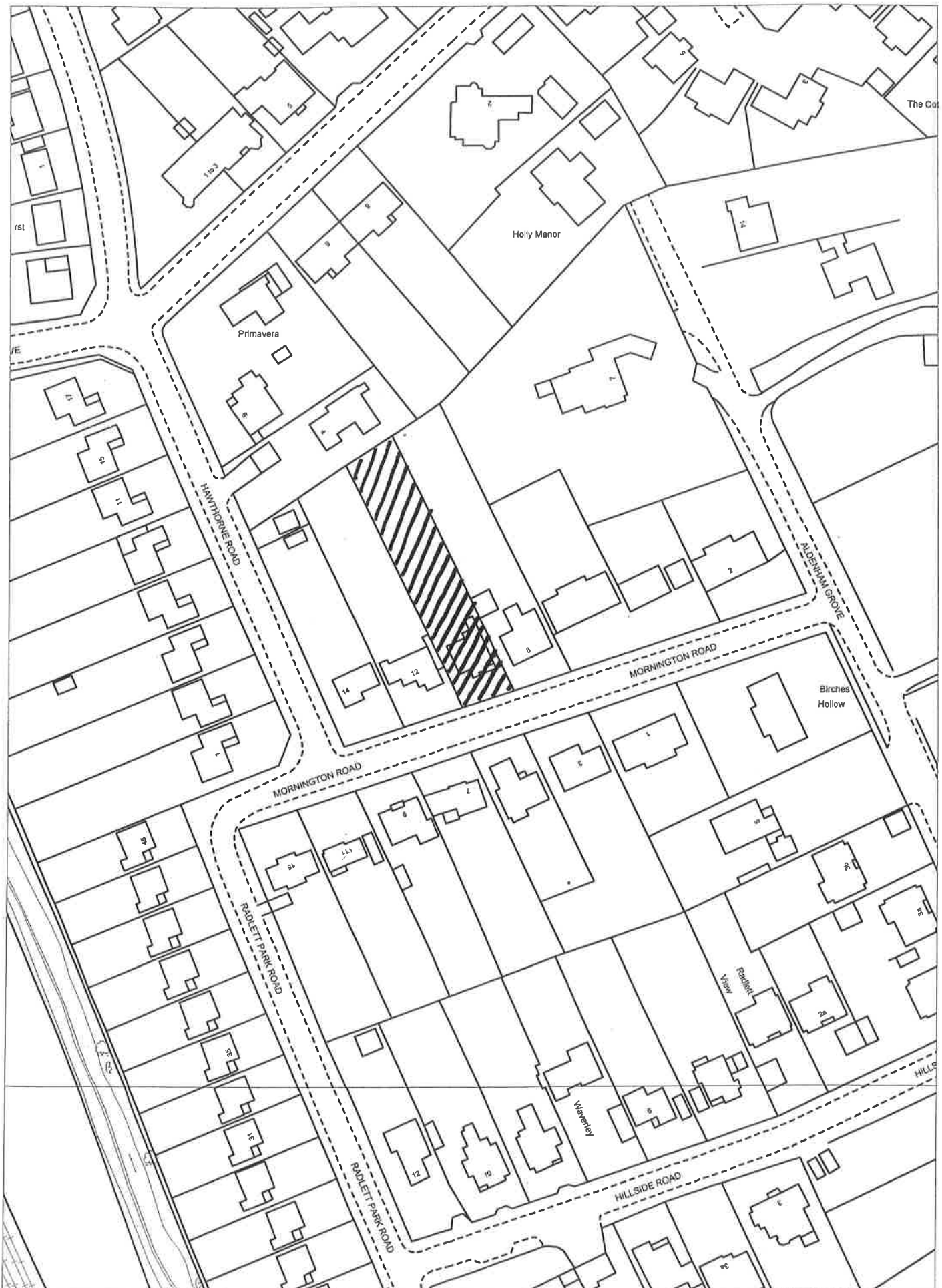
