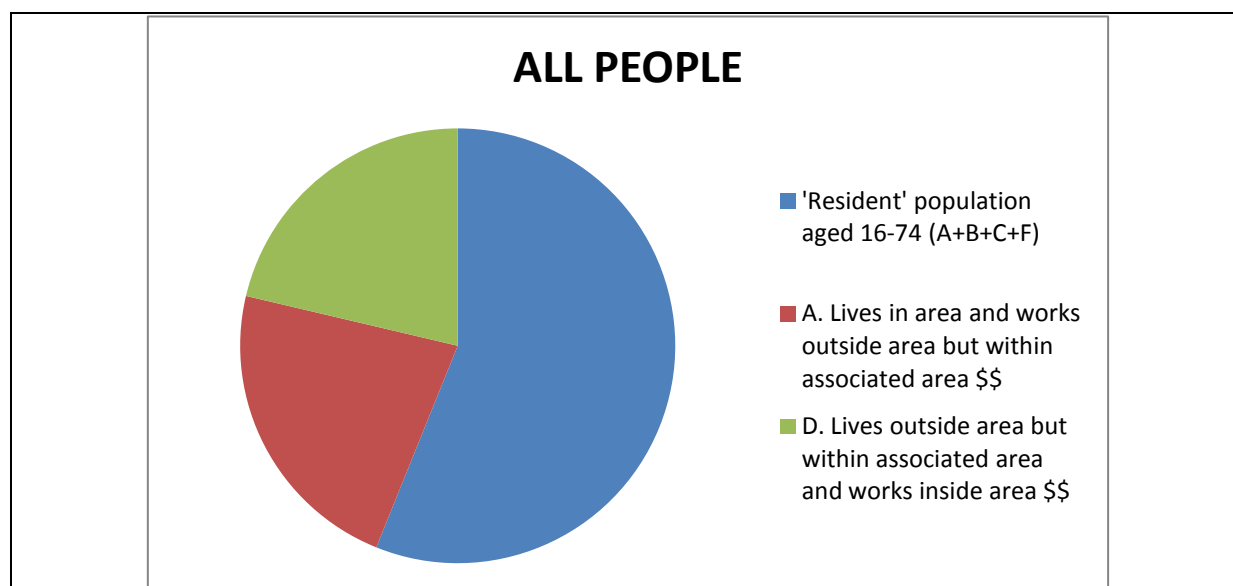

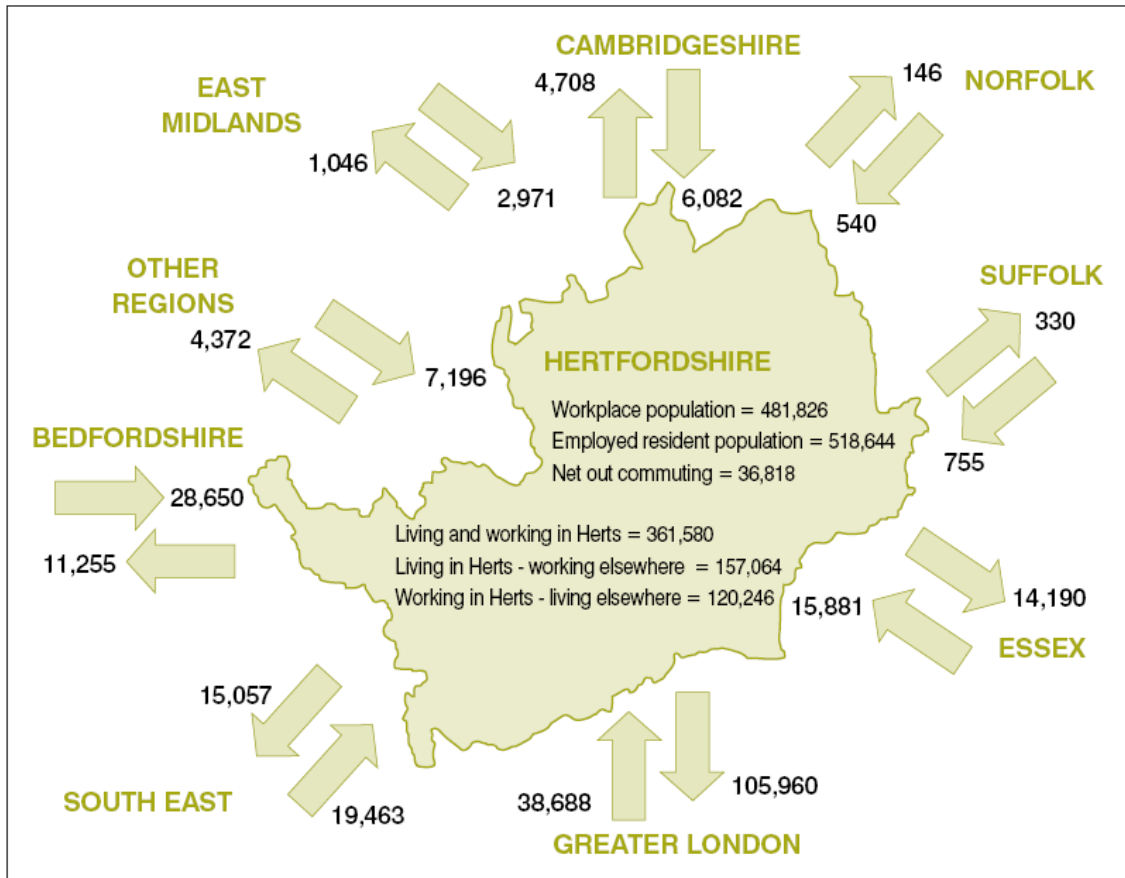

57% of those working in Hertsmere lived outside it



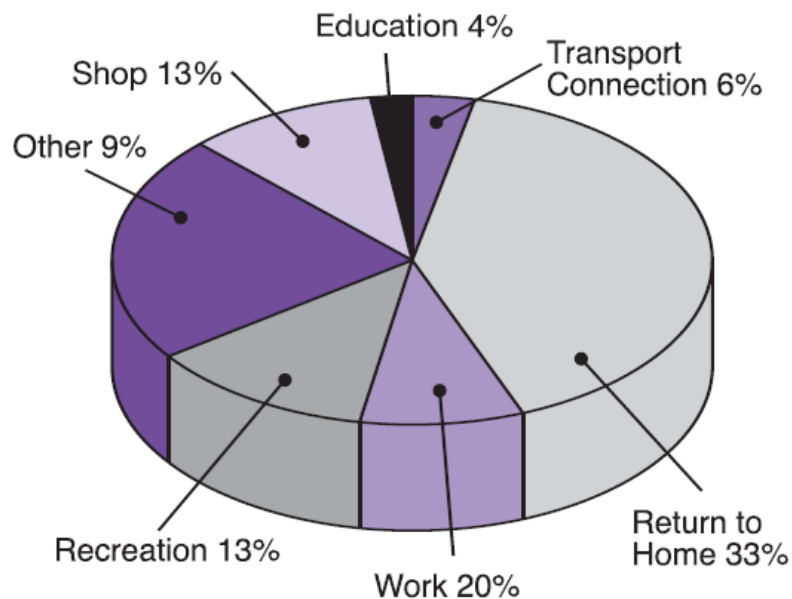

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It should further be remembered that work movements represent a relatively small fraction of total movement in Hertfordshire as the following pie shows, with shopping and recreation trips exceeding work demand although the latter is given greater attention because it occurs with peak pressures and is therefore more congested.

**Figure 3.14 Journey Purpose**



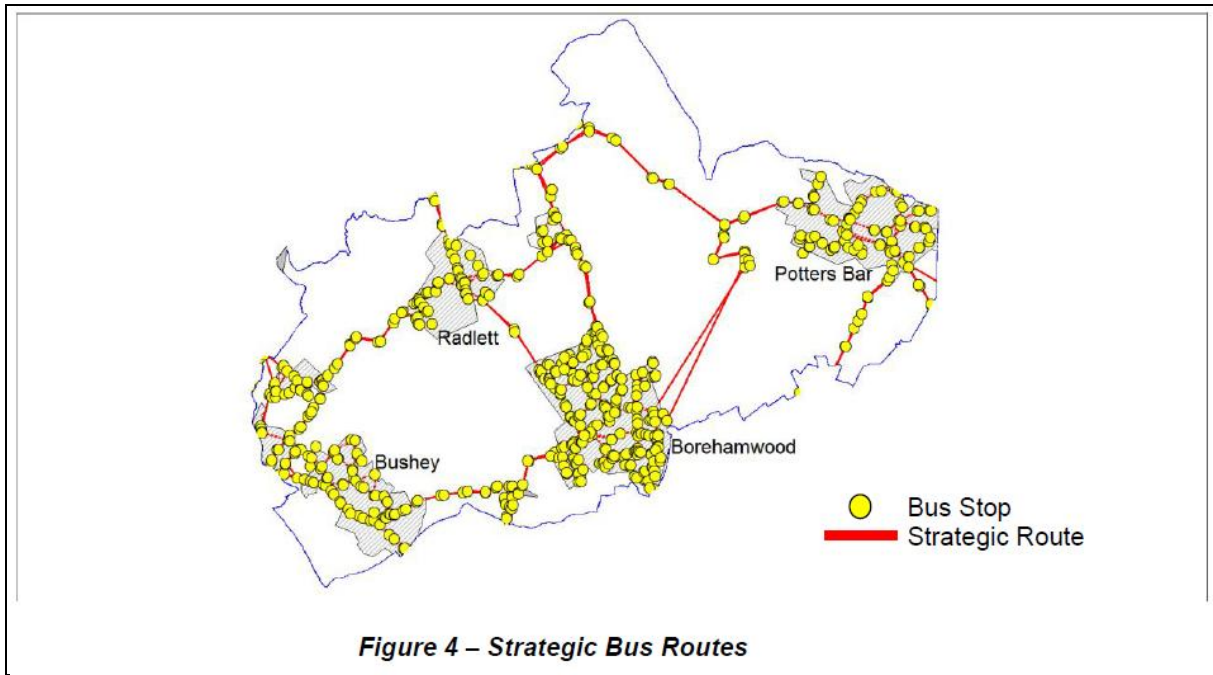
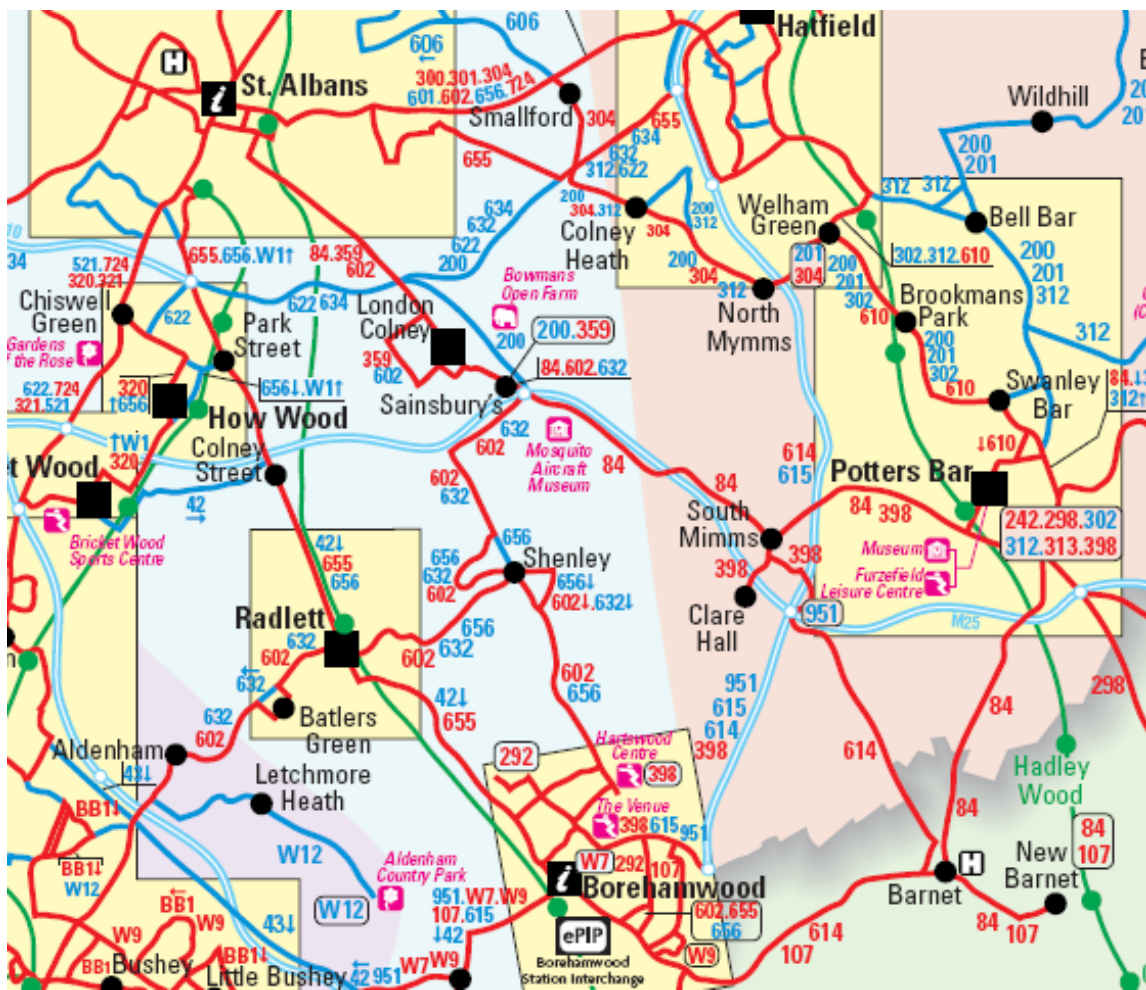


Figure 4 – Strategic Bus Routes
