

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF THE SITE ALLOCATIONS AND DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT (SADM) POLICIES PLAN

PLANNING AND COMPULSORY PURCHASE ACT 2004 (AS AMENDED)

THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (LOCAL PLANNING) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, that the Site Allocations and Development Management (SADM) Policies Plan ('the Plan') was formally adopted by Hertsmere Borough Council on 23rd November 2016.

The SADM Policies Plan has three main purposes:

- to provide environmental and other criteria, against which all development proposals and planning applications can be judged;
- to define sites and areas, as shown on a separate policies map; and
- to deliver the policies set out in the Hertsmere Core Strategy 2013.

Now adopted, the Plan is a statutory development plan document and forms part of the Local Plan for Hertsmere. Together with Hertsmere's other Development Plan Documents it forms the basis for decisions on land use planning affecting the Borough.

The Plan was the subject of an independent examination conducted by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The Inspector's Report was published in September 2015 and the recommended Main Modifications have been included in the adopted plan, along with a series of minor, Additional Modifications. A separate, updated Policies Map has also been produced.
