HBC says that the Paddock must be protected because there is a general deficit of parks and gardens in Bushey. HBC fails to acknowledge the beautiful 2 acre garden at Reveley Lodge, open to the public Monday to Friday and located opposite the Paddock which is private land and not open to the public. Warren Lake and Mary Forsdyke Gardens is located nearby and open to the public every day. In addition residents close to the Paddock have open access to Stanmore Common at the end of Clay Lane, seven days a week. But more importantly HBC has failed to acknowledge Hillmead Nature Park, Bushey Heath, comprising of 3.21 acres which they manage as a HBC wood and open to the public. There is no shortage of open spaces in Bushey Heath and therefore their scoring for *Amenity benefits and sense of place* does not make sense and is unsound.
