**Informal consultation on proposed waiting restrictions for Christchurch Crescent and Loom Place, Radlett.**

Following complaints from residents and ward councillors in regards to inappropriate and inconsiderate parking in Christchurch Crescent, the council is proposing to address the ongoing concerns of residents and ward councillors by introducing timed waiting restrictions (single yellow lines) to deter inconsiderate and long term on-street parking.

This is proposed to be 'No Waiting, Monday to Friday, 2pm to 3pm. These times are reflective of that seen in the northern part of Christchurch Crescent. This will enable residents and their visitors to always have somewhere to park on street, whilst deterring long term parking on the street. We have included Loom Place in the proposal with the aim of stopping any form of parking displacement to roads nearby.

A plan showing the proposal is attached. As local residents, we are asking your views on the proposal prior to undertaking any formal consultation.
