Statement Of Reasons for Making

THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (CLARENDON ROAD and MALDEN ROAD, BOREHAMWOOD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2016

Hertsmere Borough Council has made an Order to improve amenity and prevent congestion by introducing new waiting restrictions at the junction of Malden Road and Clarendon Road, Borehamwood as specified in the Schedule to the above-mentioned Order.

The general effect of the Order is to create 'no waiting at any time' restrictions at the junction of Clarendon Road and Malden Road, to prevent inappropriate obstructive parking causing restricted manoeuvrability and access to Clarendon Mews.

This Order is necessary to improve manoeuvrability and accessibility, to improve the amenity for residents, to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

The measures contained in the Order have been subject to consultation with local and County Councillors representing the area, Hertfordshire County Council, the local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, other local organisations and groups and local residents.
