HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) HILLSIDE AVENUE ZONE C EXTENSION) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Hertsmere Borough Council, pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general effect of the Order would be to introduce residents parking places and restriction of waiting in Bullhead Road, Hillside Avenue, Kenilworth Close and Kenilworth Drive. The proposals are necessary to reduce instances of inappropriate and inconsiderate parking, to increase the available provision of parking places for residents and their visitors, improve visibility at road junctions, reduce congestion and improve road safety.
