THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (MEADOW ROAD AND SHENLEY ROAD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Hertsmere Borough Council, pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general effect of the Order would be to introduce residents parking places and restriction of waiting in Meadow Road and Shenley Road (part). The proposals are necessary to reduce instances of inappropriate and inconsiderate parking, to increase the available provision of parking places for residents and their visitors, improve visibility at road junctions, reduce congestion and improve road safety.

MR	Shenley Road: Numbers 321, 323, 325, 327

Permit Charges

Resident Permits	A maximum of one permit per household or property = £35
Visitors Permits	£15 per 20 vouchers
Annual Visitor's Parking Permit	£70
