THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (ASHWOOD ROAD, BARNET ROAD, FIRS LANE, HOLLY DRIVE AND MUTTON LANE, POTTERS BAR) (PARKING PLACES AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2017

and

THE HERTSMERE BOROUGH COUNCIL (FIRS LANE, HIGHVIEW GARDENS AND HOLLY DRIVE, POTTERS BAR) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING and REVOCATION) ORDER 2017

In order to prevent obstructive parking, improve traffic flow and road safety and to improve the amenity for local residents and others, Hertsmere Borough Council proposes to alter parking and waiting restrictions in parts of Ashwood Road, Barnet Road, Firs Lane, Highview Gardens, Holly Drive and Mutton Lane as specified in the Schedules to the above mentioned Orders.

The proposals are considered necessary to improve parking provision for residents and others in the areas.

Hertsmere Borough Council considers it necessary and expedient to make the Order in the interests of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), for preventing obstructive parking and for preserving or improving the amenity for residents and local businesses.

Consultation has been carried out with the Police, Councillors, and the Highway Authority. Consent from the Highway Authority and the police to promote these Orders have been granted.
