Council Car Park and Civic Offices Gritting Policy



Please note Hertfordshire County Council are responsible for gritting on the public highway.

During severe weather conditions, the Council aims to keep car parks open for use, as reasonably accessible as possible, for the benefit of users.

It is not the Council's policy to pre-treat car parks; treat all surface areas of the car parks or adjacent footpaths. Each car park will be treated on a reactive basis.

During severe weather, the Council will endeavour to undertake to apply grit to the carriageway/access roads in Council pay and display car parks and access road around the Civic Offices. Not all surface areas will be treated; common routes will be given priority. Gritting will only melt snow or ice once vehicles have driven over the treated area and it will not clear snowdrifts.

All visitors to our car parks have a responsibility to ensure the safety of themselves and others and to take extra care when adverse weather is forecast. When driving in a car park or walking to and from a vehicle car park users and visitors must take care as gritting does not guarantee that the surface will not be slippery.

The most severely affected car parks will be treated with priority. A decision to treat a car park is made by the duty Officer after assessing the risk to users and priority relative to other facilities.

Gritting will be carried out by the Council's Engineering team upon the request of Parking Services (for car parks) and Asset Management (for Civic Offices).
